On behalf of 2017 ICOMOS celebration of Sustainable Tourism, ICOMOS México's Scientific Committees have the pleasure to extend our call for papers and proposals to the International Icomos members, for the International Scientific Symposium which will take place in Mexico City, from 18 to 23 April, 2017.

Heritage is one of the main drivers of tourism, and sustainable tourism must be understood as the engine of development of heritage sites. The preservation, protection, efficient conservation of the natural and cultural heritage therefore embodies a privileged range for cooperation and innovation.

This first edition of the Scientific Symposium in the framework of the International Day of Monuments and Sites aims to congregate researchers interested in the themes of the event, to present their works and participate in the academic discussion

The theme of the Scientific Symposium is "**TOURISM, MANAGEMENT PLANS AND SUSTAINABILITY**". The approach of the papers shall be the exchange of field experiences under 5 Sub-themes on the following 2 formats:

1. One that allows to carry out participants into an official celebration and technical visit of the Chinampero Mexico City Urban Historic Landscape.
2. International Scientific Symposium during an academic three days sessions, as the starting point for the publication of a high level and innovative book to celebrate our 30 year challenges and opportunities of sustainable management linked with the UNESCO World Heritage nomination for Historic Center of Mexico City and Xochimilco,

- Acceptance of the abstract have the right to oral presentation of the work. The full paper, to be sent at a later date, will be reviewed for publication.
- Full articles due: June 10th, 2017. [editorial norms will be sent upon acceptance]
- Dates of the event: April 18-21, 2017
